## Hamdan Award submits a paper in Collaborative Forum of 'Education'

In the presence of His Excellency Humaid Mohammed Al Qutami, UAE Minister of Education, Mariam Al Ghawi, Head of Excellence Programs Section in Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award for Distinguished Academic Performance submitted a paper entitled 'Collaborative Role of Hamdan Award and the Ministry of Education in the Service of Educational field' during the Collaborative Forum for the Ministry of Education, Parent's Councils, and Community Institutions which was held at the Festival City Intercontinental Hotel in Dubai. The Forum was entitled "Enhancing the partnership between the school and the community". The Award also participated in the exhibitions accompanying

the forum in order to publicize itself and its role in supporting educational excellence and in improving performance towards mastery and creativity.

The paper dealt with the vision of the Award which is to be pioneer in leading excellence in educational performance and nurturing giftedness, and its mission, in improvement of the performance in education and nurturing giftedness through the best local and global programs of positive competition and cooperation which contributes to building a distinguished academic community.

Al Ghawi discussed the Award achievements in the field of talent. These achievements included the preparation of the National Plan for Nurturing the Gifted, dispatch and graduation of 40 teachers from the Professional Diploma in Gifted Education Program (batch I and II), hosting the 12th edition of the Asia Pacific Conference on Giftedness, the discovery of 62 gifted students, the Summer Program for the Talented 2010, and the preparation of forms of tendencies, interests and learning styles.

Al Ghawi uncovered the future projects which included: the preparation of discovery tools that are rationing on the environment of the UAE, the preparation of programs for patronizing the Gifted, and the development of national cadres in the field of giftedness, in addition to the preparation of counseling and guiding programs for gifted students, education and scientific publishing in the field of talent, and preparation of schools adopting Hamdan programs of the gifted and Hamdan centers of talent.

In her paper, Al Ghawi reviewed the National Plan for Nurturing the Gifted, which is a scientific framework that organizes all the practice oriented to the talented class in an integrated model that is built according to the latest theories and scientific studies. The National Plan was designed to care about all national gifted students in all schools of the UAE, as well.

Al Ghawi highlighted the programs of the National Plan for Nurturing the Gifted, which contains 7 main programs forming a scientific plan. These programs are: the program of spotting talented students, nurturing them, the development of national staff in the field of talent; education in, scientific publishing in the field of talent, partnership with institutions and partnership with entities interested in the gifted.

## 3 academic institutions win 'UNESCO – Hamdan' at its second cycle

Three educational institutions from Nepal, South Africa and Venezuela have won the second cycle of 'UNESCO-Hamdan bin Rashid Al-Maktoum Prize for Outstanding Practice and Performance in Enhancing the Effectiveness of Teachers'. Dr. Khalifa Al Suwaidi, Member of the Board of Trustees and Member of the Permanent Jury of the UNESCO -Hamdan Prize announced the winners' names during a press conference at the United Nations Organization for Education, Science and Culture «UNESCO» in Paris, France. The announcement was attended by a large number of ambassadors to UNESCO.

Mr. Qian Tang, Assistant Director-General for Education of UNESCO, Dr. Ali Al Kaabi, Member of the Permanent Jury and the General Coordinator of the Hamdan-UNESCO Prize, Dr. Eric Wright, UNESCO Representative in the Permanent Jury, and Mr. Edem Adubra Chief of Teacher Policy and Development Section in UNESCO participated in the announcement of the results.

However, Dr. Al Suwaidi conveyed greetings of His Highness Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai and Minister of Finance, patron of the award, to the officials of the UNESCO for their international efforts in the dissemination and development of education, as well as for their interest and sponsorship of the UNESCO-Hamdan Prize which rewards the efforts and best practices of teachers and which achieves its objectives successfully by stimulating teachers to excellence and creativity cycle after cycle.

Furthermore, Dr. Tang praised the efforts made by the UAE to develop its educational system through several projects and ambitious programs that provide it with strong support from the community in order to improve the quality of education to the levels that are commensurate with the future ambitions, especially since the amount of the civilized achievement in this unique country is great.

Tang referred to the personal initiatives of His Highness Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai and Minister of Finance in education by supporting students and establishing an incentive award for distinguished academic performance. He added that the UNESCO highly appreciates these efforts that reflect the advanced level of awareness and responsibility which support the work of «UNESCO » and its quest to achieve its educational and cultural objective.

In details, the Rato Bangala Foundation (Nepal), the African Institute for Mathematical Sciences Schools Enrichment Centre (South Africa) and the Banco del Libro (Venezuela) will be awarded the UNESCO-Hamdan Prize at its second cycle.

Rato Bangala Foundation is a



non-governmental organization that provides training programmes to primary and some secondary school teachers. It works closely with the Bank Street College of Education in New York, and Kathmandu University in Nepal, operating a tripartite academic Primary Teacher Training Programme. Founded in 2002, the Foundation cooperates with Nepal's Social Welfare Council.

Established in 2003, the African Institute for Mathematical Sciences Schools Enrichment Centre (AIMSSEC) works to extend educational opportunities to disadvantaged communities in South Africa, introduce new skills to the teaching of mathematics and raise standards. To date, AIMSSEC has provided courses to 800 teachers from all over South Africa.

Whereas, Venezuela's Banco del Libro, first established as an exchange center for used books in 1960, is devoted to the promotion of reading and children's literature in Latin America. It sets up school and public libraries and has created a library network and an evaluation program to select and recommend children's books.

The US\$270,000 Prize will be divided between the three organizations. Set up in 2009 with funding from Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al-Maktoum of Dubai, the Prize is awarded every two years to candidates who have shown outstanding achievement in enhancing the performance and effectiveness of teachers in developing countries or within marginalized or disadvantaged communities from the wider global context.

The prize has started its activities by receiving requests in July through «UNESCO»; the number of candidates in the current cycle of the Prize has reached 33 from different countries of the world: 17 from Asia and the Pacific, 4 from Africa, 1 from the Arab countries, 4 from Latin America, and 7 from Europe and North America.

The Prize passed through three stages: the first stage is Screening Panel, which sorted the applications according to meeting the conditions of the Prize by an ad hoc committee of educators. 21 out of 33 files at this stage were qualified.

In the second stage, 5 of experts representing the continents of the world have met in Dubai to assess the 21applications. Then grades were allotted for each application, and the list of candidates to win was prepared. Finally the third stage, which was the stage of field visits so that the jury make sure of the credibility of the submitted projects in practice. Based on these three stages, the selection of the three winners was made. The winners will be honored at the annual prize ceremony in Dubai next April.


a good response was created by the community and targeted to participate and win the prize, the requirements of excellence community always remain topless».


#### National priorities

#### **Step towards Excellence**

Dr. Khalifa Al Suwaidi, Member of the Board of Trustees. Head of Arbitration Committees of the award presented a detailed report on the 14th Cycle of competition during the press conference. He pointed out that participations were 338 in the various categories of local competitions, out of which 159 won, at 47 percent of total participations. «The participants who did not win should not thwart or surrender, on the contrary, they have to work according to the recommendations made by the award to improve their performance, as the mere participation in the award is a step on the road to excellence», stated Dr. Al Suwaidi stressing that the award will not alter or reduce its criteria in any of the categories, but participants should live up to the award criteria.

Dr. Al Suwaidi clarified that, based on feedback from the central adjudication Committee and the educational field at the 14th Cycle, the work to update the applications and interpretative guides is underway, and will be uploaded on the website of the award at the end of this month, to be available for the use of targeted before the launch of the next cycle.

He pointed out that during the 14th Cycle Hamdan Award carried out 10 training courses during October and November last year in both the 'Teacher' and the 'School' for the adjudicators in the Gulf States. Two courses were also organized in Fujairah in the categories of 'Family and 'Worker', as well as implementing a number of introductory workshops for Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award for Distinguished Academic Performance in Sheikh Zayed Housing Program and Khalifa University in Abu Dhabi and Sharjah. There had also been visits and briefings by the award management to the Sharjah and Umm Al Quwain educational zones. He revealed that 42 national adjudicators were in the central adjudication com-



mittees in the current Cycle at 84 percent of the total 50 adjudicators representing various educational institutions and community organizations in the State; including 3 adjudicators participating for the first time in the Central Adjudication.

#### Updates in Current Cycle

Dr. Al Suwaidi said that the current Cycle witnessed developments, including some changes in the application form and the ability to upload it to the Award website, i.e. the applicant was able to input data online on the application form and then print it to complete the necessary attestations prior to submission to the Coordinator of the award in the region or state. The winner 'Organization' has had the right of candidacy once more after two cycles of the Award with new project. Hamdan Award also had a page on Facebook to display updates first-hand, and to receive questions and feedback from the educational field within and outside UAE.

Furthermore, applicants in the category of educational research at the Arab level allowed researchers to par-ticipate regardless of "application" provision of their research. Whereas UAE researchers could participate at the local level by providing a study of any educational problem and application of appropriate strategies to remedy it. The quorum of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia allocated proportion increased to 12 awards, including 6 awards for males and 6 for females; so that the number of winners in each category becomes 4 of males and females.

Participations As for applications of the current Cycle in the local competitions, Dr. Al Suwaidi explained saying: they reached 338 on different groups spread over 263 in Distinguished Student category at 77.8 percent of total participations; 7 in Distinguished Academic Student category; 20 in Distinguished Teacher; 10 in Distinguished School & School Administration; 8 in Best Applied Project; 2 in Best Scientific Innovation; 2 in Distinguished Social / Psychological Worker; 3 in Distinguished Supervisor; 12 in Best Applied Educational Research; 5 in Distinguished Family; one in Distinguished Central Management; and 5 in the category of Education Supporting Organizations.

Dr. Al Suwaidi hinted that participations were focused on the category of Distinguished Student, accounting for 79.8 percent of total applications. He noted that there is only one application in the category of Distinguished Central Management after reluctant to participate for 4 consecutive cycles. In addition, there was increase from the previous Cycle in the categories of: Best Applied Educational Research, Distinguished Family, and Distinguished School & School Administration.

He pointed to the reluctance of departments of Educational Zones from participating in the categories assigned to them in this Cycle, despite the participation of Sharjah Educational Zone in the previous year which was distinguished in two of the standards of excellence for this category.

The number of participants decreased in the current Cycle at 6.6 percent, to 338 compared with 362 in the 13th Cycle.

There were 5 participations in the competition of Education Supporting Organizations from various local institutions in the UAE in the current Cycle; these entities provide services contributing to improve the performance of education in the State. These entities include: Culture. Youth and Community Development Authority, Humaid Bin Rashid Al Nuaimi Charity Foundation, Education without Borders, The Dubai Sports Council, and Traffic and Roads Agency in the Roads and Transport Authority, Dubai.

#### Adjudication and Assessment

Dr. Al Suwaidi said that working on adjudication was divided into two phases: the

He explained saying: «The victory of DEZ and KHDA and their return to the normal position in the superiority and the coronation stimulate to further work in this direction and to exploit all our potentials to make excellence a chapter in our schools. This, inevitably, would keep us at the forefront of Educational Zones, and ensures us the first place. That is the approach we derived from the dictionary of excellence that was created by our model and inspiration, His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai». first began on Saturday, 24 December last year in the Higher Colleges of Technology in Dubai, during which the chairpersons of committees and members of adjudication began assessment of a random sample from each category to unite the visions and convergence of views between the adjudicators of each category. Theoretical adjudication stage of applications continued to 4 January.

On the other hand, the second phase began on Thursday, 5 January, and ended on Wednesday 7 March; this phase was personal interviews and field visits to competitors who were qualified to the second phase of the adjudication. The number of candidates for the second phase of the adjudication filtered to 202 out of 338 participants at 60 percent of the total participants.

#### **Analysis of the Results**

The analysis of the results of the 14th Cycle shows that Dubai Educational Zone and the Knowledge and Human Development Authority topped in the number of participations with 88, followed by Abu Dhabi Educational Zone with 85; then the rest of the educational zones.

Dubai Educational Zone and the Knowledge and Human Development Authority also topped educational zones by obtaining the largest number of awards in the category of Distinguished Student, at 41 winners, followed by Abu Dhabi Educational Zone at 30.

Dubai Education Zone and the Knowledge and Human Development Authority were the only to be awarded the category of Best Scientific Innovation, as Sharjah Educational Zone was alone to get the award of the Distinguished Supervisor category. Besides, the Distinguished School & School Administration category was awarded to: Western Educational Zone by obtaining one, Dubai Educational Zone and the Knowledge and Human Development Award Authority by obtaining another and the Sharjah Educational Award by obtaining the third.

As higher education institutions, Khalifa University of Science, Technology and Research, Abu Dhabi obtained the only Best Applied Project award.

The Best Applied Educational Research award was focused in Abu Dhabi by obtaining one award and Dubai Knowledge and Human Development by obtaining the other.

In the category of Distinguished Teacher, Abu Dhabi won 3 awards out of 9 winners in this category, and Al Ain Educational Zone got two, Sharjah Office with two, Dubai and the Knowledge and Human Development had one, and Fujairah Educational Zone got the same.

In Distinguished Academic Student, 6 students won the award: 3 winners from Khalifa University of Science, Technology and Research, Abu Dhabi, one from the Faculty of Engineering, Sharjah, one from the American University of Sharjah, and the last was from the Higher Colleges of Technology in Ras Al Khaimah.

Traffic & Roads of the RTA in Dubai got the award of Education Supporting Organizations for the current Cycle. While Distinguished Central Administration award was suspended for this Cycle.

#### **Gulf Competition**

With regard to competitions at the Gulf level, Dr. Al Suwaidi said that the management of the award carried out 10 training workshops for adjudicators from the Gulf countries in both categories: Distinguished Teacher, and Distinguished School & School Administration. The coordinators of the award, members of the jury in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and some of the winners were invited to attend the 6th Arbitration Forum on 26 October, and the Sixth Seminar of Best Practices in academic performance on 27 October.

One of the GCC adjudicators discussed a paper during his presentation in adjudication

Forum about adjudication practices and the difficulties facing the competition in the Gulf States.

Taking into account the particularity of the education system in the Kingdom, two coordinators were allocated to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia: one for boys and another for girls with an assistant for each one of them.

The committees began to assess applications in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) on Thursday, 24 December, and the second phase of adjudication finished interviews and field visits on Monday, 20 February.

The total number of participants from GCC was 69 participants spread over 30 participants in the category of Distinguished Student (13 boys and 17 girls) at 60 percent of the total number of participations allocated to the Gulf states; 20 participants in

Saudi Arabia came first in the number with 35 participations, followed by Kuwait with 16, then the Kingdom of Bahrain with 14, and Qatar with 4. The total number of participants was 43 female and 26 male - out of which to 36 participants were qualified to the second phase of adjudication (field visits and personal interviews) in the Gulf. Winners in the competitions from GCC according to the categories spread on: 7 winners in the category of Distinguished Student, 6 in Distinguished Teacher, and 6 winners in the category of Distinguished School.


Again, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia came first in the number of winners by gaining 11 awards, followed by Kuwait and Bahrain obtaining 3, then Qatar by obtaining two awards of the total awards. Male winners were 7 whereas females 12 of the total numbers allocated.

#### **Arab Educational Research**

As for the Educational Research Award for the Arab Nation, preparations of the competitors synchronized with the rest of the competitions. Advertising and advisory campaign started at the beginning of September 2011 along with the distribution of publications of this category in all Arab countries. Special committee was formed with the mission of undertaking the task of receiving research of researchers, and then providing management of the award with the results on the dates specified in advance. Participations in the current Cycle amounted to 28 from of 7 Arab countries, and Saudi Arabia topped with 18. Only one research from Egypt won the Award for the second

won the Award for the second time in a row since the launch of Arab award.
