«Al Maktoum Charity Foundation» and «Hamdan Award» financing UNESCO's charity and education projects

United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization «UNESCO» has singed two memorandums of understanding with Al Maktoum Charity Foundation, and Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award for Distinguished Academic Performance to finance charitable and education projects by allocating a grant of two million US Dollars «7.34 million Dirhams». Where one million Dollars will be allocated to support the project «Building teacher's skills for implementation of teacher-centred policies of curricula reform», while the second million, granted by Al Maktoum Charity Foundation, was allocated to contribute to the support of UNESCO's human and cultural projects in several countries.



H. H. Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai and Minister of Finance, has met H. E. Irina Bokova, Director-General of UNESCO, in Paris on the occasion of his official visit to the International Organization.

H. H. described the UNESCO as «The incubator of education and culture in the world», and added: «I am proud and pride to be at the headquarters of UNESCO today in response to the kind invitation I have received from H. E. Irina Bokova, Director-General of UNESCO to whom I have the utmost respect».

H. H. expressed his appreciation for the efforts exerted by «UNESCO» to improve human society through the dissemination of education and knowledge as well as combating poverty and underdevelopment, and its contributions to building the future of the world civilization on the basis of a culture of peace, freedom, justice, equality, dialogue , and respect for the other in order to reach the welfare and happiness of the humanity.

Moreover, H. H. E. Humaid Mohammed Al Quttami, Minister of Education and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award for Distinguished Academic Performance, confirmed that the cooperation between the Award and UNESCO has created opportunities for the development of the relationship in the interest of global education.

He also pointed out that the recent understandings between the two parties promise to expand contributions of the Award in the education area, and achieve objectives of H. H., sponsor of the Award, which is an extension of the kind initiatives of H. H. Sheikh Hamdan, alluding that they represent a practical interpretation of his care to support UNESCO's efforts to achieve the goals of sustainable development, and build a global community based on peace, love, justice, equality and stability.

H. H. explained that the UAE is a partner of UNESCO in several projects including UNESCO's schools, Regional Centre for Educational Research, in addition to a number of awards like Hamdan Award.

He explained that human responsibility requires to back and support international efforts to establish civilizational values, supporting responsible freedom and peace process, enabling dialogue and multiculturalism, accepting the other in human coexistence, and encouraging efforts on deployment and development of education, as well as development of the culture to achieve noble goals, and solve many issues which are plaguing the modern world, especially poverty, ignorance and illiteracy.

Director-General of UNESCO also praised achievements made by the UAE in the field of heritage conservation and modernity embrace by drawing the attention to the experience of the country in the areas of good education, water management, and maintaining of intangible heritage.

She also valued the UNESCO-Hamdan Prize joint venture to reward outstanding practices and efforts to improve teachers performance, stressing on the role they play in the teachers performance development, dissemination, creation and deployment of certain practices which will increase the value of education, so as to achieve human development goals.
