



Expo 2020 Gains Dubai ... Future is Created Here



The United Arab Emirates has gained a new international achievement by winning the bid to organize Expo 2020, the biggest and most prestigious world exhibition as Dubai could overcome the competitors in the voting process that took place in the Paris, France. Votes were limited to the Member States in the Bureau International des Expositions (BIE), the responsible authority for organizing the Expos, which controls selecting the hosting countries of Expo which is held every five years. President His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, in a telephone conversation, has congratulated Vice President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai, His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, on Dubai's winning the bid to host Expo 2020.

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa affirmed that "our joy in the UAE was double by the win as it coincides with the celebrations of the 42nd National Day." He noted that this success was the culmination of the series of successes and great achievements the UAE has been incessantly making since its establishment 42 years ago to remain in the lead in all fields.

His Highness said: "From day one when we submitted our bid

to host Expo 2020, we were fully confident that Dubai deserves to win the bid, and that our country possesses all it takes to successfully organize a unique event that will add a new and outstanding imprint on the Expo series of events."

Dubai received 116 votes out of a total of 165 members of the BIE, after excluding three member states: Costa Rica, Chad, and South Sudan from voting for procedural reasons.

The voting took place in Paris, France at the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) conference center.

The vote result was in favor of the UAE's hosting bid, beating bids of cities of Sao Paulo (Brazil), Ekaterinburg (Russia) and Izmir (Turkey). The result was settled in favor of the UAE through the secret ballot, which was limited to the delegates of Member States in the BIE only.

The UAE has achieved a record in the number of votes in the first round by getting 77 votes out of total 162 votes, as three countries have abstained. The Brazilian Sao Paulo left the competition in this round.

Dubai continued its supremacy in the second round by adding ten more votes as the total countries voting in favor of Dubai became 87 countries.

Then Dubai was culminated by winning over Ekaterinburg in







the last round at a total of 116 votes choosing Dubai to host Expo 2020.

Holding Expo 2020 in Dubai at the start of the next decade will coincide with celebrations of the Golden Jubilee of the foundation of the United Arab Emirates. This will be reflected positively on the event deepening its symbolism as the country celebrates the first truly remarkable achievement witnessed by this country. The UAE boom which enabled the country to win the oldest and largest global exhibition stems from this historic agreement which resulted in the establishment of the State of the Union.

UAE Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum dedicated this achievement to his brethren the UAE President His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, who has the credit for the achievement which is unprecedented in the region, Their Highnesses Members of the Supreme Council, Rulers of the Emirates and to the people of the UAE, who participated in making the national honorable epic by supporting the initiative with all possible means.

HH Sheikh Mohammed said: "We congratulate the nation, our president and all people in the UAE on Dubai's winning bid to host the greatest exhibition in the world. I extend my thanks to HH Sheikh Khalifa for his great support, and to every country that voted for Dubai to host Expo 2020. I am proud of our teams who earned this victory for Dubai with two years of hard work, dedication and commitment."

Dubai is the center of the world

The UAE is the third largest re-export market in the world, with more than 9 seaports; the thing which ensures its high position as the largest container terminal. Dubai International Financial Center is home to 18 of the top 25 global banks, 6 out of the 10 top law firms, and 6 of the 10 largest insurers in the world.

50% of the energy required to run the suites and facilities of 'Dubai Expo 2020' comes from renewable energy sources, and the architectural buildings left from Expo 2020 will be preserved as memorial symbolizing the enhancement of communication among people and bringing about real positive change.

Dubai Metro Red Line will be extended to reach the Expo site, and a new station will be built to serve the exhibition.

The UAE has the logistic capacity sufficient to host Expo 2020 in Dubai, as 80,000 hotel rooms will be ready to provide the best means of comfort for guests.

Dubai has unique and worldclass infrastructure in roads and transport sector as the UAE ranked first globally in roads quality, according to the report of the World Economic Forum 'Davos' for 2013 -2014.

The Expo Live provides new channel to connect innovative projects of different countries with funding sources and partners, allowing the benefit from the expertise and access to markets and users.

The Expo Live includes rich programs consisting of workshops, forums, conferences and meetings around the world to raise awareness, promote sharing knowledge and enhance cooperation. Expo





Live events will be held over the next seven years with the aim of identifying and defining Expo challenges. €100 million euros has been allocated to support different projects of Expo Live which can provide new solutions for mobility, sustainability and opportunities. Application will be available to all countries.

Over the past six years, Dubai government has spent more than 70 billion dirhams to develop the world-class infrastructure in the road and transportation sector.

The UAE ranked first regionally and 11th globally in the field of quality infrastructure for transportation, according to the report of Global Enabling Trade 2012 issued by the World Economic Forum in Switzerland.

Dubai dominates 80% of the exhibitions held in the region which include the Arab region, Gulf and some parts of Asia. The new exhibition center in Al Maktoum Airport would be the largest in the world. It will be built on about three million square meters area and is expected to be completed in 2020.

Expected to be completed by 2020, the capacity of Al Maktoum International Airport will be 12 million tons of cargo annually along with serving 160 million passengers.

Festivals & Events Association. Dubai ranked among the top six cities for the establishment of festivals and events in the world. It is one of the 10 most attractive cities for tourists, as it was visited by more than 9.3 million tourists only last year.

Over the 150-year history of its organization, Expo has never been hosted by any of the Middle East, Africa and Southeast Asia (MEASA) countries.

Organizing Expo in Dubai represents the first time ever in which Expo is organized in the vast MEASA region. Moreover, holding Expo in Dubai will have a significant positive impact on the peoples of the MEASA region.

The World Expo 2020 in Dubai will be a human celebration of new ideas and global partnerships, as it will achieve sustainable benefits for future generations.

Dubai potentials of high-re-

liability infrastructure, huge airports and seaports, logistic support and advanced means of communications and technologies prove Dubai's ability to host Expo 2020.

Objectives and values of the World Expo are consistent with the aspirations of the UAE leadership and people as the UAE will receive the world to mark the cultural diversity and joint achievements during the exhibition.

Dubai, and the UAE in general, owns the ability to attract millions of visitors to Expo 2020 as the show will have a positive impact on the region by contributing to the creation of new opportunities to the countries and peoples of the region in a manner exceeding the boundaries of Dubai and the United Arab Emirates.

The period between October 2020 and April 2021 is ideal for hosting Expo 2020 as it is a distinct period in terms of climate and rich wonderful global events.

Dubai financial returns gained from Expo 2020 are expected to be more than 139 billion dirhams (around €28.8 billion euros).

Dubai Expo 2020 will contribute to the creation of about 280,000 jobs in the UAE, and preserve the sustainability of 1,400,000 jobs regionally in the period from 2013 to 2021. The UAE can be accessed via 4-hour flights from one-third of the world countries and 8-hour flights from of twothirds of the world countries. Hosting Expo 2020 in Dubai will ensure the easiest access for the visitors from all over the world.

Dubai Expo 2020 will create job opportunities for people who live outside the United Arab Emirates, which leads to the growth of the region by young and energetic hands.





280,000 jobs in UAE by 2020

UAE is the 3rd world largest re-export market

Expo 2020 is an important step in the development process of the United Arab Emirates to achieve the objectives of UAE 2021 Vision, to consolidate the national pride and to strengthen the UAE's position on the global arena.

Dubai Expo 2020 is an important opportunity for young people in the UAE and the region to share views, learn from each other and help shape their common future.

Dubai International Airport ranked third in the world in terms of the number of passengers in 2012 with about 58 million passengers compared to 56.5 million at the beginning of the same year; while Abu Dhabi International Airport served about 12.4 million passengers in 2011.

The UAE is a global hub for trade and logistics. It is the third largest re-export market in the world operating more than 9 seaports, with the largest container terminal

between Rotterdam and Singapore.

In 2011, Dubai hosted about 9.3 million visitors with total revenue at a sum of USD \$4.36. It ranked 9 among the 20 most dynamic and pioneer cities in the world in terms of tourist arrivals and ranked 9 among the top 10 most attractive destinations for starting business. In 2011, the hotel guests in Abu Dhabi exceeded 2.1 million and Sharjah was visited by over 1.5 million tourists. In 2012, the Dubai Mall received more than 65 million visitors.

The youth less than 20 years are 50% of the population of the UAE. Surveyed opinions of young people in 12 Middle Eastern countries in 2012 showed that the UAE is the model that they would like to see their countries follow in terms of growth and development.

The UAE supports the small and medium enterprises

(SME) that make up 95% of the companies registered in the country. SMEs can play an important role in Expo 2020. The UAE ranks 27 globally as per the Global Competitiveness Report.

79% of the UAE's foreign aids are concentrated to support the development programs, and the UAE will allow developing countries to take part in Dubai Expo 2020. Dubai and the UAE have a proven track record of international events, such as meetings of the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank, World Economic Forum, Dubai Airshow, and the Dubai World Cup for horse racing, international tennis tournaments, Art Dubai Exhibition, Dubai International Film Festival, World Future Energy Summit, Grand Prix of Formula 1 and Abu Dhabi Film Festival. Such eventful record supplied Dubai and the UAE with the experience and

resources necessary to host Expo 2020.

The campaign theme "Connecting Minds, Creating the Future" was inspired from the vision and leadership of His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, and reflects the vision of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai. who said: "Intellectual communication is the best way to progress, success and coexistence for future generations". The UAE looks forward to Expo as an important opportunity for gathering intellectuals to provide solutions for the current and future global challenges.

Furthermore, the United Arab Emirates will celebrate the 50th anniversary of its founding in 2021, and Expo is a unique opportunity to mark the great achievements of this young state.

Tens of thousands of people in different departments and institutions, schools and even homes took part in the celebration by hoisting the UAE at the same time in response to the national campaign launched by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai on the occasion of Flag Day. Educational System.. Modern and Strategic Link between **Qualifications and Market**

Within its social policy and development, the United Arab Emirates gave systematic and ongoing attention to develop the educational process in all stages since it was established, because education is one of the essential foundations and pillars for sustainable development and building modern societies, due to the social status assumed by education as one of the main components of the Human Development Index issued by the United Nations.

On December 2, the United Arab Emirates celebrates the 42nd National Day in time educational indicators show remarkable development over the past decades, which is consistent with the UAE policies and interest in developing all elements of educational process because the human being is the core and purpose of development at the same time.

This has been quite evident in the UAE Vision 2021, which aims to make all Emiratis, each in his position, contribute to the construction of their nation, through the development of their knowledge and promotion of innovation principle, development and knowledge economy.

The number of students in the academic year 2012 – 2013 has increased by 3097% hitting 728,918 students, compared to the academic year 1970 - 1971 when they were 22,800 students. The number of schools in 2012 - 2013 also increased by 1624% reaching 1276 schools compared to 74 schools only.

The programs of public, higher and academic education accounted for 21% of the total budget of the federal government in 2014 amounting to AED 9.8 billion, spread over AED 6 billion for public education and the remaining for academic education. Most of this budget will be spent on

programs improving the learning levels of student as well as academic and research excellence, in addition to programs to qualify graduates that would become leaders in their fields and are qualified to meet the needs of the labor market.

The UAE endeavors to provide a variety of options and opportunities to obtain modern education within a policy and strategy framework linking among building the UAE nationals' qualifications, outputs of education, needs of the labor market, and developments and social changes associated with the developments taking place in the UAE in various

Formal education in the UAE began in the 1950s, by many individual initiatives, according to the characteristics and conditions of each society at that point of history. Then, it was followed by increasing the number of the educational missions coming from neighboring countries; the thing which contributed to spread education in some major cities. However, the official educational process had been launched with the establishment of the Federation of the United Arab Emirates, which contributed to start the development and construction stage in various fields. Over the past decades, Education has been the major concern of the government, which adopted the plans and strategies to develop it. Among the government's most important priorities was achieving its objectives to take education to the standard levels whereupon the government leans to achieve its policies and aspirations of the future, in accordance with the best practices and international models that lead to the establishment of modern educational process.

The indicators of education sector for 2011 - 2012 has shown the potential positive developments witnessed by the sector, particularly in the area of the government's efforts to provide educational infrastructure of high quality, All of the above have been reflected on the large increase in the number of schools and their capacity, as well as the increase in the number of students enrolled in the UAE schools and universities.

The total number of schools in the UAE during 2011 - 2012 amounted to 1,185 schools, including 691 government schools, 483 private schools, 11 applied technology and technical high schools. These schools include 859,224 students, 41,164 classrooms, 57,799 teachers, and 32,921 administration and technical staff.

The number of students per teacher amounted to 14.87, and the number of students per class was 20.87 at all stages.

The official statistics indicate a steady increase in the number of students at various stages of public education, as the number of students increased from 814,729 students in 2010 - 2011, to 859,224 students during the 2011 - 2012, with an increase of 44,495 students.

Regarding the rate of participation in higher education in the UAE, the total number of universities, colleges and institutes in the country amounted to 81, including 3 government universities, 6 colleges, 30 private universities, 30 colleges and 12 institutes. During 2011 - 2012, the total number of students in higher education of government and private institutions reached 196,366 students, while the number of male students in government education was 51,250 students, and their number in private education was 34,829 students, compared to the 75,221 female students in government education, and 35,066 students in private education.

The total of UAE nationals in

the higher education institutions of government and private sector hit 57.98%, while the expatriates represent 42.02% of the total number of students. UAE national students of higher education are centered in government institutions at 65.54%, while, on the other hand, it is noted that expatriate students of higher education are centered in private institutions at of 55.71%. The academic year 2011 – 2012 has seen the graduation of 19,257 students from various institutions of higher education.

Furthermore, the indicators reflect the outstanding performance in terms of ensuring enabling children across the country (male and female alike) to complete the primary education stages by 2015. According to these values, the UAE was able to achieve the targeted percentage within the specified time, i.e. before 2015, as well as the presence of sustained growth for the rest of the educational indicators on all elements, whether those relating to the infrastructure or education services, or those relating to the numbers of students, alumni, and other derivative indicators; the thing which proves the successes achieved by the UAE since its establishment in terms of promoting education in all its forms. This also contributed to the increase of growth rates of education indicators at all levels of education. In the period (1990 - 2010), the number of students has increased at annual growth rate of 10.3%, and that was accompanied with an increase in the number of schools by similar rates, as well as an increase in the number of teachers at a rate of roughly 13.3%. The UAE adopted the compulsory education to the 9th grade of primary education to eliminate dropping out conditions of students at this stage, advancing in great strides in providing a seat for every student in the country.
